

Beyond the Brush - Open Call for Artists, Guidelines

Theme: Heartbeat of Heritage

Group Exhibition: November 29-30, 2024

Eligibility: All visual artists

Admissible Media:

Painting

- Sculpture
- Drawing
- Ceramics
- Photography
- Mixed Media

Submission Guidelines:

- Submission Deadline: July 31, 2024.
- **Number of Entries:** Each artist can submit up to 3 pieces.
- **File Format:** All submissions must be in JPEG format, 300 DPI, and should not exceed 5MB per image.
- **File Naming:** Each file should be named as follows: The artist's full name, title of work, Medium, size, and year the art was created. For eg: Johndoe_[title of work]_ Material_20x30_2024
- Work exhibited at Beyond the Brush 2023, will **NOT** be accepted.
- Submission is free.

Artwork Requirements:

- Artworks must be original and created by the artist.
- Artworks should align with the theme "Heartbeat of Heritage."

"Heartbeat of Heritage," is an art exhibition that will celebrate the rich and diverse cultural tapestry of Guyana. This event honors the stories, traditions, and spirit that define our nation. It's a celebration of Guyanese culture. Honor our past, appreciate our present

- **Traditional Art Forms:** Discover indigenous art and colonial-era paintings that narrate Guyana's historical journey.
- Contemporary Interpretations: Explore modern artworks reinterpreting our heritage through a contemporary lens.
- Artworks must be ready for exhibition (framed or otherwise prepared for display).

Application Process:

- Please share pictures of your work so that your entry can be approved. You'll
 have time later to send in the official pictures of pieces for the show.

Selection Process:

- A jury of professional artists and a curator will review all submissions.
- Selected artists will be notified via email by August 12, 2024.

Exhibition Details:

- Selected artworks will be part of the "Heartbeat of Heritage" group exhibition in November 2024.
- The exhibition will be held at The Palazzo.
- Artists will be responsible for shipping their artworks to and from the gallery.

Additional Information:

- FineArt.gy will take a 20% commission on any sales made during the exhibition.
- Artists are encouraged to attend the opening reception and networking space;
 however, attendance is not mandatory.
